

*Reminder: These confessions are not to get the blessing; the blessing and prosperity are already ours by the work of Jesus. Confessing these verses helps to renew our minds to this fact and give us boldness to stand against (1) any lie of the enemy that would cause us to doubt it or (2) any work of the enemy that would try to steal it.*

### **Abundant Life Confessions**

- John 10:10                      Jesus, You came to give me life and that I have it abundantly. I receive it!
- 3 John 2                              I am Beloved! God wishes above all things that I prosper and be in health, even as my soul prospers.
- Matt 6:25-33                      I will not worry about my life – any part. God knows what I need. I will simply seek first His kingdom and His way of doing and being right, and all I need will be added to me.
- Phil 4:6/I Peter 5:7-10      I will not worry or be anxious. I will be humble, trusting in God not myself. I cast all my cares on Him, for He cares for me. I resist the enemy; I stand firm in faith.
- Jeremiah 17:7-8                I am blessed, for I trust in the Lord, Who is my hope. I am like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river. I will not fear when heat comes; but my leaf will be green, and I will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will I cease from yielding fruit.
- Psalms 1:1-3                      I am blessed. I do not walk in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit in the seat of the scornful; but my delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law I meditate day and night. I am like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also **will not** wither; and whatever I do **will** prosper.
- Psalms 84:10-12                God is a sun and shield to me. The Lord gives me grace and glory; **no** good thing will He withhold from me. I am blessed because I trust in You!
- Hebrews 11:6                    Without faith it is impossible to please God. I believe that God is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
- Psalms 5:11-12                I rejoice because I put my trust in You; I shout for joy, because You defend me; I am joyful in You because I love Your name. For You, O Lord, will bless me; with favor You will surround me as with a shield.
- Proverbs 3:1-6                I will keep God's commands; for length of days and long life and peace they will add to me. Mercy and truth will not forsake me; I bind them around my neck and write them on the tablet of my heart, and so find favor and high esteem in the sight of God and man. I trust in the Lord with all my heart, and lean not on

	my own understanding; in all my ways I acknowledge Him, and He directs my paths.
Proverbs 4:7-9	Wisdom is the principal thing. I go to God, and He gives me wisdom. I also have understanding. Honor, grace, and a crown of glory are mine.
Proverbs 2:6-7	The Lord gives me wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for me; He is a shield to me.
James 1:5	I <i>never</i> lack in wisdom because I ask God, and He gives it to me in abundance.
James 3:17	I have wisdom that is pure, peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.
Proverbs 3:13-18	I find wisdom and am happy. I have understanding; for her proceeds are better than the profits of silver, and her gain than fine gold. She is more precious than rubies, and all the things I may desire cannot compare with her. Length of days is in her right hand, in her left hand riches and honor. Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace. She is a tree of life to me who takes hold of her, and happy am I who retains her.
Proverbs 8:17-21	I have wisdom because I seek wisdom. Because wisdom is mine, riches and honor are mine – enduring riches and righteousness! Wisdom brings me income and leads me in right paths so that I inherit wealth and fill my treasuries.
Isaiah 48:15	God has called me. He has brought me, and my way will prosper. Thus says the Lord, my Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to profit, who leads you by the way you should go.
2 Chronicles 1:12	Wisdom and knowledge are granted to me; God gives me riches and wealth and honor...
Jeremiah 29:11	God thinks about me, and His thoughts are of peace and not of evil, to give me a future and a hope.
Isaiah 45:2-3	God goes before me and makes the crooked places straight: He will break in pieces the gates of brass and cut in sunder the bars of iron. He gives me the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, so that all may know He is God.
Psalms 85:12	Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and my land will yield its increase.
Joshua 1:5	No man shall be able to stand before me all the days of my life; as God was with Moses, so God will be with me. God will never leave me nor forsake me.

Joshua 1:7-8 I am strong and very courageous, and I do what God commands me to do. I will not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, and I prosper wherever I go. The Word of God will not depart from my mouth. I will meditate in it day and night and will do according to all that is in it. For then God makes my way prosperous, and I will have good success.

2 Corinthians 9:8-11 All grace abounds to me, and I always have all sufficiency in all things for more than enough for every good work. God gives me seed to sow and meets my needs. God multiplies the seed I sow and increases the fruits of my righteousness, all the time I am enriched in everything for giving liberally, which causes thanksgiving to God.

Psalm 132:12-18 Because I keep His covenant and learn from the Spirit, I will reign forever. The Lord lives in me. He blesses me with provision and salvation, and I will shout with joy. He makes me strong, causes me to grow, and His anointing is in me and on me. My enemies are brought to shame, while I flourish.

Psalm 112:1-4 Praise the Lord! I am blessed because I fear the Lord, who delights in leading me by His commands. My descendants are mighty on the earth; My generations are blessed. Wealth and riches are mine, and my righteousness (thanks to Jesus) is forever. I will always have light when others have darkness. God is good to me.

Malachi 3:10-12 I bring all my tithes into the storehouse so that God always has supply. Because of this, the windows of heaven are open to me and blessings pour out on me – so much that I can not possibly contain it all! The devourer is rebuked for me, and he can not destroy the fruit of my ground nor cause my vines to fail to bear fruit for me in the field. All see me and call me blessed.

Proverbs 3:9-10 I honor the Lord with my possessions and with the firstfruits of all my increase, so my barns are filled with plenty and my vats overflow.

Isaiah 30:23 God gives rain for my seed and gives bread from the increase. It will be fat and plentiful.

Luke 6:38 I give, and it is given to me: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be given to me.

2 Corinthians 9:6-7 I sow bountifully and reap bountifully. I purpose to give with a good heart because God loves a cheerful giver.

Philippians 4:19 and my God shall supply all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Deuteronomy 8:7-10 The Lord my God is bringing me into a good land, with a wealth of provision and supply and beauty and anointing in abundance. Praise God for His bountiful blessings!

Deuteronomy 8:17-18 I will always remember that the Lord my God has given me and continues to give me the power to get wealth. And this wealth proves His covenant with me.

Proverbs 10:22 The blessing of the Lord makes me rich, and He adds no sorrow with it.

Deuteronomy 7:13 God loves me and blesses me and multiplies me. He also blesses my family and my income.

Psalms 35:27 The Lord has pleasure in my prosperity!

Psalms 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not lack.

Psalms 37:3-5 I delight myself in God, and He gives me the desires of my heart. I commit my ways to the Lord, trusting in Him, and He brings it to pass.

Psalms 92:12-15 I flourish like a palm no matter what the heat. Because I am planted in the house of God, I flourish. I bear fruit into old age, am fresh and flourishing, and declare that God is good! He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

Job 36:11 My days are spent in prosperity, and my years in pleasures.

Psalms 37:25-26 I am not and never will be forsaken nor will I ever need to beg for bread. I am merciful and I lend; and I and my descendants are blessed.

Luke 12:32 I will never fear, because it is my Father's good pleasure to give me the kingdom.

Psalms 103:2-5 God is full of benefits! He forgives all my iniquities, He heals all my diseases. He redeems my life from destruction. He crowns my life with lovingkindness and tender mercies. He satisfies my mouth with good things, so that my youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalms 107:35-38 God turns a wilderness into pools of water, and dry land into watersprings. I, the hungry, dwell there, sow fields there, and yield a fruitful harvest there. God blesses me and multiplies me, and never allows decrease.

Psalms 34:10 I seek the Lord and **never** lack any good thing.

Deuteronomy 28:2 The blessing has come upon me and overtakes me. I am blessed in the city, and blessed in the country. The fruit of my body, the produce of my ground, and all my increase is blessed. My basket is blessed; my bowl is blessed. I am blessed when I come in, and blessed when I go out. Enemies who rise against me are

defeated before my face. The Lord commands the blessing on me in my storehouses and all to which I set my hand. Everyone will see that I am called by the name of the Lord.

- Deut. 28:11-13      The Lord gives me plenty of goods, and He opens to me His good treasure to give rain to my land in season and to bless all the work of my hands. I will lend and not borrow. I am the head and not the tail. I am above only, and not beneath.
- Ephesians 1:17-23      I have the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him. My eyes of understanding are opened so that I know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.
- Galatians 3:29      I am Christ's, and Abraham's seed, and an heir according to the promise.
- Hebrews 7:19-22      Jesus became the guarantee to me of an even better covenant than the Old Testament believers had.
- Hebrews 8:6      Jesus is my Mediator of a **better covenant** with **better promises**.
- Nehemiah 9:21      You sustained the Israelites in the wilderness for forty years. They lacked nothing; their clothes did not wear out and their feet did not swell. I will never lack.
- Genesis 13:2      Abram was very rich in livestock, in silver, and in gold.
- Genesis 13:5-6      Lot also, who went with Abram, had flocks and herds and tents. Now the land was not able to support them, that they might dwell together, for their possessions were so great that they could not dwell together.
- Job 1:1-4      Job feared God and shunned evil. He had seven sons and three daughters. His possessions were such that he was the greatest of all the people of the East...and the Lord restored Job's losses when he prayed for his friends. Indeed the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before.
- Ecclesiastes 7:8      the end of a thing is better than its beginning.

1 Kings 3-10	Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the men of the East and all the wisdom of Egypt, for he was wiser than all men...Solomon's riches and honor were unlike any other man or king of his days.
Isaiah 58:11	The Lord guides me continually, satisfies my soul in drought, and strengthens my bones; I am like a well watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.
Haggai 2:7-9	I am filled with God's glory. The silver and gold are His. He gives me peace.
Leviticus 26:3-5	God gives me rain in season. The land yields its produce, and the trees yield their fruit. I will eat to the full and dwell safely.
1 Kings 2:3	I will obey the Lord and will prosper in all that I do and wherever I turn.
Deuteronomy 6:18	It is well with me, and I go in and possess the land.
Psalms 115:11-16	God is my help and my shield. He thinks of me and blesses me. He blesses me whether I am small or great. I increase more and more – me and my children.
Genesis 17:6-7	God has made me fruitful and continues to make me exceedingly fruitful.
Psalms 107:31	Thank You, God, for Your goodness and for Your wonderful works!
Ecclesiastes 2:26	I have faith in God, and He provides. He gives me wisdom, knowledge and joy.
Proverbs 13:22	The blessing will enable me to leave an inheritance to my children's children, but the wealth of the wicked is stored up for the righteous.
Deuteronomy 32:13	The Lord causes me to ride in the heights of the earth, to eat produce from the fields, to draw honey from rocks, and oil from flinty rocks.
Genesis 39:2-4	The Lord is with me and causes me to be successful. The Lord makes all that I do to prosper and causes me to find favor.
Proverbs 13:13	I respect the Word and do the Word, and I am rewarded.
Galatians 6:9	I will not get weary in well doing; for in due season I will reap if I don't faint.
Hebrews 6:12	I do not become sluggish; I imitate those who through <i>faith</i> and <i>patience</i> inherit the promises. God, Himself, has said, "Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you."
Matthew 18:18-19	Whatever I bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever I loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. If two of us will agree on earth concerning anything that we ask, it will be done for us by My Father in heaven.

Luke 10:19 I have authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing shall in any way hurt me.

Numbers 23:19-20 God is not a man that He should lie. Has He not said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

Isaiah 55:10-11 For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall God's word be that goes forth from His mouth; it shall not return to Him void, but it shall accomplish what He pleases, and it shall prosper in the thing for which He sent it.

Jeremiah 1:12 God has said, "I watch over My word to perform it."

Hebrews 1:3 God upholds all things by the word of His power.

Hebrews 4:12 The word of God is alive and powerful.

Ephesians 3:19-21 I know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; I am filled with all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, above all that I ask or think according to the power that works in me, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever.
